

Covid-testing protocol for EAWA day clients

All EAWA day care clients must have a twice weekly PCR test depending on the level of their attendance.

E.g. if they attend once a week, then it is One PCR test a week. If they attend three/four times a week, then it is a twice weekly PCR test.

This is undertaken at the day centre for existing clients at the Wheatsheaf Hall premises, Main Avenue, Bush Hill Park, Enfield EN1 1DS

For New Clients, the first PCR test must be arranged with the Day Care Centre Manager. She will instruct when and where it can be undertaken.

In addition to this, on the days of Day care attendance, each client must have a Lateral Flow Test (LFT).

A photo of the test result with the name and date of the client must be sent to the EAWA Day centre manager.

The Day centre Manager has created a What's App group for this, so all photos of results can be stored.

The PCR and LFT results **must be negative** for a Day care client to attend.

If a positive result is lodged, then the client must isolate in line with Government guidelines.

The Day centre manager will contact the client concerned.

All EAWA staff undergo daily LFT's which must be negative.

New Day Care Clients will be assessed on Zoom and must undertake the above testing process, before a trial visit can be agreed.

Everyone must have taken their 2 vaccines plus the Booster jab and have a negative lateral flow test to participate in our services.
